Frank DeSantis joins the Saints

Mountain View Christian Schools (MVCS) is pleased to announce its recent hire of Frank DeSantis, as a member of Saints Athletics team. DeSantis will be the Saints head football coach, head baseball coach and will focus upon training and developing athletes and maximizing the use of the school's 20-acre facility.

DeSantis comes to MVCS with 34 years of experience in the field of education and athletics. Most recently, DeSantis worked as the Athletic Administrator and high school football and baseball coach at The Meadows School in Las Vegas. There, he was named the NIAA 2A Division Athletic Director of the Year twice; led the football team to seven (7) state championships in nine (9) championship game appearances over 14 seasons; led the baseball team to the playoffs in 10 consecutive seasons, winning one (1) state championship in three (3) championship game appearances. DeSantis' 41-game winning streak from 1998-2001 is the Nevada state record for 11-man football. DeSantis' comprehensive background in athletics and education excites MVCS Executive Principal, Raymond LeBoeuf.

"I believe that Frank is a future member of the Nevada Sports Hall of Fame. His contributions to this community as a player and coach at UNLV and long time colleague in high school athletics stands for itself. Our present and future school families will be blessed to benefit from Frank's knowledge, experience, and guidance." LeBoeuf said.

MVCS Athletic Director, Kaitlin Glover added that she is "really excited to work along side Frank. His experience and connections in the community are a valuable asset to this organization and our department."

DeSantis has totaled 145 wins over 17 seasons as the head football coach at The Meadows School, Cimarron (2002) and Eldorado (2003-04). Previous to coaching in high school, DeSantis was a coach in UNLV's baseball program from 1983-92. DeSantis was the team's catcher from 1979-82, and was drafted in the 8th round by the Chicago Cubs in 1982.
