

FAQ - TUITION, SCHOLARSHIPS, GRANTS

When do I pay enrollment fees?

Once a student is re-enrolled through the family portal, new student enrollment fees of \$250 are due through FACTS to save the student's spot for the 2022-23 school year.

What if I need to enroll a new student in my family for the next school year?

If you need to enroll a new student that is in your household for the 2022-23 school year, you don't need to wait two weeks for enrollment to open up for new students. Please send an email to leromero@mvcs.net you can be emailed a 2022-23 enrollment application or told how to complete one online.

When is tuition due and can I pay online?

Tuition & fees are paid online through FACTS. All families are set up with a tuition account when they enroll their student(s). Account statements of activity, choice of payment methods, and flexible due dates are available through the tuition account. Tuition may be paid in 10, 11 or 12 installments (beginning in July and ending in July) each year.

What if my family shares tuition between households?

Families may set up multiple tuition accounts to split student tuition & fees. The accounting office will need the designated tuition split to be set up if it hasn't already been done in the previous years.

How do I apply for tuition assistance?

Applications for an MVCS Grant are reviewed annually. In order to be eligible for renewal this school year a new MVCS Grant form will be required to be signed and all outstanding past due balances should be up to date for application to be reviewed and considered for the 2022-23 school year.

What if my student(s) currently is on an Opportunity Scholarship?

Current MVCS families getting Opportunity Scholarship assistance will be required to re-enroll to the organization prior to submitting an MVCS grant application. Upon receiving the letter of denial or acceptance, please contact leromero@mvcs.net to discuss the next step and calculate the 2022-23 tuition based on the new amount awarded.

Am I still required to pay for registration and initial fees if I am pending a Opportunity Scholarship response?

Yes, registration and initial fees are still required to be paid at time of re-enrollment. Once you get your awarded letter in the mail initial fees will be discussed. If the amount awarded covers all fees due, a reimbursement will be issued when payment is received from the scholarship organization.

What if I am not eligible to apply for an MVCS Grant?

A completed application must be submitted along with the previous calendar year tax return in order to be considered for MVCS grant assistance. All applications are subject to funds available. The assistance pool is funded by the general school budget and donations.

Do I have to apply for tuition assistance every year?

Yes. Tuition assistance is awarded for one year only. Applications must be submitted each year to receive assistance. Applications will be reviewed within 10-14 business days and you will be contacted by Lorena Romero to set up an appointment and sign MVCS Grant paperwork or meet with Mr. LeBoeuf, Principal if needed.

How much of tuition can be covered by tuition assistance?

MVCS Grant is generally able to help cover tuition only. All other initial fees are required to be paid by the parent.

Are volunteer hours required for families receiving tuition assistance?

All tuition assistance recipients starting 2022-23 will be assigned volunteer hours based upon the amount of MVCS Grant awarded to the family. The volunteer hours are an important component to the tuition assistance program because the volunteers perform functions which might otherwise need to be performed by paid staff. This frees up funds to be included in the tuition assistance pool which might otherwise need to be used for payroll. Volunteer hours should be completed on campus or at extracurricular activities and need to be completed by the end of the school year. Tuition assistance may be withheld in a subsequent year if all hours are not completed on time.
